Veteran Bitch 5(1a)

1st Tarlton Triodan Tsara to Tomnil 7 year old Tricolour with a pretty head. Large eyes and good pigment. Arched neck and well laid shoulders. Good for size.

2nd Tarabad Ch Kaidee Kiss me Kate Khatibi Blen 10 year old. Looking very good for age. Lovely head and well broken markings. Lovely size and shape. Was not very happy on the move today.

3rd Stanton Cavisdale Reggae Music at Cassandy.

Special Veteran Bitch (10years and over) 5 (2a)

1st Claydon Ch Brymarden Moon River JW.14 year old in January, this lovely bitch still keeps going. Beautiful head with a lovely eye and expression. Excellent neck length and well laid shoulders. Well sprung rib, and level top line. She can still move round the ring like a 2 year old. Although in the challenge for best veteran I think ran out of steam.

2nd Hobbs Wynciliff Lady Karly of Beaconsflyde Black and Tan 13 year old. Lovely dark eye. Short body, good spring of rib. Excellent tan, just slightly dropped her top line on the move.

3rd Wimberley Starofvinci Arabella at Trishine

MPB. 11

1st Sedgebeer Russmic Jasmine Rose. 7 month old. This bitch caught my eye as she came in the ring. Lovely rich colour. Pretty head with large dark round eyes, excellent pigment. Correct mouth. Medium neck and Good shoulders placing, good spring of rib, short coupled. Well angulated hindquarters. Level top line and good tail carriage on the move. Loved her forward reach and back movement. BPB.

2nd Juzandia Morwena.9 month old. Another beautiful well broken Blen Puppy. Extremely pretty head with large expressive eyes, and excellent pigment. Good neck and shoulders, Good for size, another lovely mover with level top line. Just not quite as confident as 1.

3rd Craig Aldechell Zoe Ze

PB 17 (5a)

1st Lovel Lovetrac Boogie Wonderland. 11 month old Blen in lovely coat. Very pretty head with lovely eyes and dark pigment. Med neck and well laid shoulders, good spring of rib. Moved well.

2nd Kilcoyne Granasil Castanet 8 month old ruby. Good rich colour. Good body shape and excellent top line. Well angulated hindquarters. Went well on the move.

3rd Levy & Sedgwick Pascavale Felicity

JB 15 (4a)

1st Long Arroline Euphoria 15 month old well broken Blen. Very eye catching, lovely head with dark eyes giving a lovely expression. Excellent pigment. Well set ears. Correct neck and good shoulder placement. Short coupled. Well angulated hindquarters which she used on the move.

2nd Rhodes Colonlan Pretty in Pink, and she is pretty. Nearly 12 months old, and very similar to my 1st just not as mature or in as good a coat as 1.

3rd Ireland Glebeheath Jezebel at Charnell.

YB 14 (1a)

1st Spall Llapsttams Killer Queen. 22 month Black and Tan beautifully turned out in excellent coat with rich tan markings. Large dark eyes, good for pigment. Well made body with excellent spring of rib, good neck and shoulders. Short coupled. Well angulated hindquarters, giving excellent movement. Kept a level top line all the time. Considered this bitch for top honours.

2nd Jones Charnell Moonshine for Ameldinay. 23 months. Extremely pretty bitch of lovely size and shape. Well broken and good for colour. Good neck and shoulders, level top line and good tail carriage. Moved well.

3rd Callaghan Ellemich Parisienne at Callyspride JW.

NB 14 (2a)

1st Loades Rosirius Bluebell. 15 month old well broken Blen. Dark eyes and good pigment. Excellent size, good body shape. Moved well.

2nd Long Arroline Utopia Litter sister to the winner of JB. Very much the same in size and shape. Preferred the head and top line of her sister.

3rd Barrowclough Brymarden Isador.

Sp. Grad Blen or Tri. 10 (3a)

1st Long Arroline Euphoria see JB.

2nd Richardson Kringleholme Seruna. This is a very pretty bitch with gorgeous eyes. Good for size with excellent neck and shoulders, good body shape. Moved well. Just slightly paler in coat than 1.

3rd Pipkin Salegreen my Delphinium for Ryanmil

Sp. Grad Black & Tan or Ruby.

1st Rogerson Rabymar Paper Lace 2 year old black and tan in good coat with rich tan markings. Pretty with large dark eye and excellent pigment. Well laid shoulders and well sprung rib. Good for size. Moved well.

2nd Berwick Harana Peggy Lee Merrylaine Richly marked ruby of excellent size. Lovely head and eye, good neck and shoulders. A little proud of her tail today.

3rd Quilter Karaime's Wishing on a star.

PG10 (1a)

1st Mc Murray Cinderac Are you For Me at Merryoth. Attractive well broken Blen. Pretty head, Large expressive eyes. Excellent neck and shoulder placement. Short coupled with good top line and tail carriage. Well angulated hindquarters. Excellent mover.

2nd Rennards Deranmar Evensong Pretty Black and Tan bitch again a lovely size. In good coat and condition. Lovely head large eye and good pigment. Well ribbed body. Moved well.

3rd Roberts Pauroi Lavish Alice.

1st Claydon Brymarden Honeybun. Extremely pretty well broken Blen. Lovely expressive eyes, good nose pigment. Flat top skull, well cushioned muzzle. Lovely neck and shoulders, well sprung rib. Short coupled, lovely top line which she kept on the move. Good front and rear action. Excellent temperament. RCC.

2nd Rix & Berry Ricksbury Royal Tapestry. Another pretty bitch with large dark eyes which gives the correct expression. Medium neck and well laid shoulders. Good spring of rib and excellent top line. Went well on the move. Just not in as good coat as 1st.

3rd Levy and Sedgwick Pascavale Patrice.

LB 6 (1a)

1st Lee Colonlan Perfect Kiss for Kelrick JW SchM. Lovely sized Blen with good coat. Pretty head with lovely eye and excellent pigment. Good neck and shoulders, Good spring of rib. Lovely size. Moved well.

2nd Hogan Miletree Ophelia at Stavonga JW. Well broken Blen, in good coat. Very pretty head with Dark eyes and good pigment. Lovely shape and size. Was not as settled on the move and my 1st.

3rd Almonroyd Catch a Wish at Borrowlain

OB 6

1st Smith Ch Crimbledale Jemima at Beaudale. A beautiful Black and Tan in excellent coat and condition. Rich tan markings. Loved her head with those lovely dark eyes giving the soft expression you want to see in a cavalier. Dark pigment. Well cushioned muzzle. Good ear set. Excellent neck and shoulders, well sprung rib. Short coupled with a super top line and tail carriage. Well angulated hindquarters, which gave her excellent drive. Lovely temperament. Was pleased to award her the CC, and after the referee's decision she went Best in Show.

2nd Ch Magic Charms Witch Woman. A very pretty blen with beautiful eyes. Lovely size and shape, in good coat. Preferred the rear movement of my 1st.

3rd Whitfield Aristor Topaz for Bevelmount.

Sp Bred by Exh. 2.

1st Mynott Honeybet Just a Minute. Lovely sized Tricolour With pretty head. Lovely eyes and good pigment. Well laid shoulders and good spring of rib. Well angulated hindquarters giving her good movement.

2nd Hogan Stavonga Angel Eyes. Well broken Blen with dark eyes and good pigment. Well shaped body. Moved well.
